ATR VERDICT: Shaheen had a subsequent winner back in fourth when regaining the winning thread at Pontefract recently, and attempts to follow up off a 4lb higher mark. He does have ground to make up on EQUITANT, who was ahead of him at Haydock previously and has since run well again at the Merseyside track. Star Cracker got going too late over 5f here on Monday, whereas his stablemate Tommy G drops back in distance after performing slightly below his best over 7f at Musselburgh.
