ATR VERDICT: ALGAFFAAL made a promising start to his racing career when three-parts of a length second on the Tapeta at Newcastle and, with a handy inside draw, he could prove difficult to beat with normal improvement. Why We Dream has earned a rating of 79 with a number of solid efforts and will find this assignment much easier than when finishing 11th in the Sandringham Handicap at Royal Ascot latest. She is the obvious danger, although Gamesters Icon also brings some solid form to the table, and Joie De Vivre and Bin Makfi are both interesting newcomers.
