**ATR VERDICT:** Nuns Walk got the victory her recent form deserved when scoring at Newcastle and has leading claims once again here from just 4lb higher in the ratings. However, preference is for the hat-trick seeking DIZZY G, who has thrived since joining the handicap ranks and Karl Burke's progressive filly can defy a 6lb penalty here. Hugo Palmer's C&D winner Power To Exceed can't be ignored, while Rotherhithe is interesting on her first outing for Richard Fahey having hit the frame on three starts for Robyn Bristland last year.
