ATR VERDICT: PEDISNAP ran creditably in defeat on turf at Limerick last time and is expected to do better back on Polytrack off 1lb lower. A draw in stall 10 is a slight negative, but the four-year-old looks open to more improvement than the likes of Beau Satchel, who might be using this to prepare for a tilt at Galway later in the month. Shelbe should go well with the champion jockey on board, while Nisior Donn looks to be going the right way for Gavin Cromwell.
