ATR VERDICT: JUNEAU has been in cracking form and won well enough on her latest outing at Haydock last week to suggest that she can defy a 6lb penalty. Bossiney Bay is a filly that has been steadily improving and the form of her third-placed finish in a classified stakes event at Doncaster looks strong with the second winning subsequently. She is likely to give a good account on her handicap debut, while Berkshire Spirit also merits consideration following his narrow defeat on a similar undulating track at Brighton.
