ATR VERDICT: Mirage Dancer was well backed leading up to the Wolferton at Royal Ascot but was never able to land a blow behind Monarchs Glen when finishing fifth. The return to 1m4f is in his favour but he meets BARSANTI again who beat him when the pair met in the Buckhounds Stakes at Ascot over this trip in May. Roger Varian's gelding will find this an easier task than trying to beat Crystal Ocean in the Hardwicke. The Sheikh Hamdan pair, Muntahaa (third) and Laraaib (ninth), both contested the Wolferton where the former bounced back to form and the latter disappointed. The latter is of interest tackling 1m4f for the first time and could go close if returning to his Sandown form behind Poet's Word. Raa Atoll is another fascinating contender as he could easily have gone for the Bahrain Trophy earlier on this card and will be a potent threat getting the weight-for-age allowance at a track that should suit him better than Ascot where he finished fourth in the King Edward VII Stakes.
