ATR VERDICT: Jaayiz got off the mark for Richard Hannon at Brighton last time and this two-year-old should have more to give despite a wider-than-ideal draw, while Yellow Fire represents in-form connections but is another who hasn't been done any favours by the draw. It could be worth chancing FIVE HELMETS, who boasts course experience and shaped as though the step up to 7f would suit him perfectly at Haydock last time.
