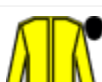

ATR VERDICT: Wissahickon won nicely at York on his handicap debut 13 days ago when getting the better of Beringer and the son of Tapit is still on the upgrade with this only his fifth career outing. Zaaki has to carry top-weight but ran a fine race when third behind Hunting Horn in the Hampton Court at Royal Ascot and should post a bold showing on that evidence. Mark Johnston's pair, Communique and Poet's Prince, cannot be discounted with the Middleham handler having won four of the last five renewals, but the pair need to return to the form they showed in the London Gold Cup at Newbury where they finished ahead of CHIEF IRONSIDE. The son of Lawman stepped forward from that third-placed effort when winning over this C&D a fortnight ago and still looks to have more to offer, despite a 7lb rise.
