ATR VERDICT: It may be a clue in itself the Ryan Moore takes over aboard David Elsworth's Victoria Cup winner RIPP ORF, who steps back up to a mile having followed up his Ascot success with a near miss over this distance at Newbury, and a disappointment back down at 7f at Epsom. Corrosive was well fancied when beaten five lengths in the Britannia Stakes at Royal Ascot and the two-time winner this term could easily be on the premises here. Vitamin is 5lb higher than when landing a C&D handicap cosy enough last month, while Beverley maiden winner Court Of Justice is another to watch out for on his handicap bow.
