








ATR VERDICT: Groveman warrants plenty of respect following his comfortable victory over 1m2f at Bath, and Eden Rose merits consideration with her sights lowered for last year's winning stable. However, preference is for top-weight RECKLESS WAVE, who takes a significant drop in grade after contesting class 3 handicaps on her last couple of starts, and her form at this sort of level earlier in the year was rock-solid.
