The way he finished on that occasion suggested he would have no issue with the extra half-mile and he remains unexposed over the larger obstacles. Lotus Pond is respected in his bid for a hat-trick of wins under Rules, while Top Billing can go well back over fences having finished third over hurdles here in May.
