**ATR VERDICT:** SURREY BLAZE ran on well to lead near the finish in a 1m4f handicap at Leicester last time and seemingly won a shade cosily. There could be further improvement to come from Joseph Tuite's charge following a 4lb rise in the ratings. Hallingham is rated 6lb lower than when winning over track and trip last year and is the one expected to put up most resistance. Warofindependence, 3lb higher in the handicap than for his all-weather win in May, looks best of the rest.
