ATR VERDICT: This can go the way of MISHAAL, who didn't set the world alight in a better race at Pontefract last time but previously looked progressive in this grade in smaller fields. A mark of 66 looks there to be taken advantage of and Michael Herrington's charge can get the better of Kraka (also engaged to run at Thirsk on Tuesday), who is well drawn and wears first-time cheekpieces, and Lackaday, who might just be overpriced as a two-time course winner with Paul Hanagan on board.
