



ATR VERDICT: TIMOSHENKO has improved considerably for a step up in trip on his last couple of starts in handicaps and there is every chance he could have more to offer with the application of first-time cheekpieces. Giovanni Medici also improved for going up half a mile in distance when second at Kempton in April and he has a tongue-tie to potentially eke out improvement, while blinkers could make a difference to Spice War.
