ATR VERDICT: Oeil De Tigre warrants plenty of respect in his bid to complete the four-timer, but he has a further 7lb rise to cope worth and isn't partnered by regular rider Sophie Ralston this time. Instead, the vote goes to PORTO FERRO, who has won twice at this venue in the past, including last time out, and he teams up with the excellent Nicola Currie. Hollie Doyle is the only jockey in the line-up who doesn't claim and she gets the leg up on May Remain, who is entitled to improve for his comeback fourth at Windsor.
