ATR VERDICT: Nigel Tinkler's course and distance WHINMOOR has risen 19lb in the handicap since winning at Carlisle in June and is now fancied to land a hat-trick and confirm form with Paparazzi, who was three lengths adrift last time. Despite being better off at the ratings this time around, the latter has developed a rather unhelpful knack of just falling short. The lightly-raced Cuddington cost plenty as a yearling and is a potential improver back on turf, while Kylie Rules is respected off the same mark as when second at Hamilton two starts ago.
