

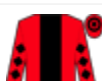

ATR VERDICT: John Quinn's Ascot Week broke his duck at Newcastle late last month and it is interesting that the Malton handler now swaps cheekpieces for a first-time visor on the four-year-old as he looks to follow up from a 3lb higher mark. Lotara has to be respected having knocked on the door the last twice and is still just 2lb higher than when last scoring, while Mark Johnston's course winner Ravenhoe is always foolish to rule out. However, Irish raider MARKHAN gets the nod here for the irresistible Jamie Spencer and Gordon Elliott combination and the gelding is 1lb lower than when third at Naas last time out.
