ATR VERDICT: Course-and-distance winner ARABIAN JAZZ has knocked on the door the last twice and was somewhat unlucky not to have held on when sent off favourite at Yarmouth last time. A 2lb rise for that narrow defeat appears fair and it would be no surprise to see Michael Bell's filly back in the winner's enclosure with Jamie Spencer taking over in the saddle. Super Florence was beaten a neck here over five furlongs last time and is interesting jumping up two furlongs now, while Edge Of The World is still only 4lb higher than when scoring at Leicester earlier this term and has to be considered on this year's form making her first start for John Quinn having changed hands for 70,000gns in July.
