**ATR VERDICT:** The form of LOVE TO BREEZE's handicap debut second at Goodwood looks rock solid, with the winner following up and being narrowly beaten in Group 2 company since, and Ed Vaughan's filly can go one better off this 4lb higher mark. Majrooh was touched off at Pontefract when last sighted and makes plenty of appeal returning to the scene of his latest victory, while Trulee Scrumptious is difficult to dismiss having won six times on the July course in the past.
