**ATR VERDICT:** This looks all about RIPP ORF, whose only lacklustre performance so far this year came on soft ground at Epsom. His course form is encouraging, first and second in two visits, and he will prove extremely difficult to beat if reproducing the form of his latest third in the International Stakes at Ascot. Lake Volta was surrounded by subsequent winners when three-parts of a length third at Newbury and he warrants plenty of respect off a 1lb lower mark, while the consistent Spanish City is unlikely to be far away either.
