ATR VERDICT: Destroyer enjoyed the run of the race when last sighted over a mile at Newmarket and should give it his best shot on the front end, though narrow preference is instead for BROTHER MCGONAGALL, who was touched off by under a length over a mile at Ayr last time. A 1lb rise for that performance appears fair in view of the fact the winner has gone in again at Glorious Goodwood since. Hajjam, a 7f winner here in June, could play a supporting role.
