ATR VERDICT: AIR OF YORK has been knocking hard on the door in recent starts and was thwarted by just a neck off this mark at Chepstow on his penultimate outing. John Flint's six-year-old wouldn't need to find a great deal of improvement in order to get back on the winning trail. The Groove has slipped to a good mark and is expected to step up on a solid third on debut for David Evans at Chepstow, while the unexposed Bidding War may emerge as the pick of the three-year-olds.
