ATR VERDICT: Sunhill Lad could feasibly step up on his latest effort over 1m6f at Redcar now cutting back in trip and fitted with first-time cheekpieces, though narrow preference is for KITTY'S COVE, who is a potential improver off a mark of 48 on her handicap debut. Tim Easterby's High Chaparral filly is closely related to 1m4f winner Forced Family Fun. A stiffer test of stamina may also suit Handsome Bob, who steps up beyond 1m2f for the first time.
