ATR VERDICT: Our Little Pony struck over C&D off 4lb lower on her penultimate outing and should show up well from a low draw, while recent Redcar winner Wrenthorpe makes obvious appeal as he attempts to defy a 4lb rise in the ratings. It may, however, be worth overlooking GOLD STONE's poor effort on soft ground at York last time now she returns to a C&D over which she landed a novice contest on good ground last summer. Her penultimate second on the all-weather at Wolverhampton suggests this 1lb lower mark is within her capabilities.
