

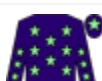

ATR VERDICT: It might pay to side with seasonal/handicap debutant DUBAWI PRINCE, who looked an exciting prospect when winning his maiden at Doncaster in April 2017 and ran as though something was amiss when bombing out in a hot conditions race next time. Back from the sidelines off an attractive mark of 84, he shades the verdict ahead of Great Beyond, who has had wind surgery since last sighted and wears a first-time tongue-tie, and the more experienced Gododdin.
