







ATR VERDICT: Swordbill wears cheekpieces for the first time and must enter calculations lining up off the same mark as when runner-up at Catterick, but OAKLEY MIMOSA shades the verdict in receipt of 2lb. She clearly likes the place, having won and finished third on her last couple of starts over 1m2f here, and it's interesting that a first-time tongue-tie is equipped now upped in distance. Refrain, Konigin and True North add further spice to the contest.
