**ATR VERDICT:** TOO DARN HOT confirmed the promise that he displayed when making a winning debut at Sandown by taking the Group 3 Solario Stakes at the same venue a few weeks later. On that occasion he was four lengths ahead of the Chesham winner Arthur Kitt, while he beat Confiding with more ease than Dark Vision did in the Vintage. Based on that performance the son of Dubawi is very hard to oppose this afternoon. The aforementioned Dark Vision is the main threat but needs to take another step forward to beat the selection. The form of Phoenix Of Spain's Acomb victory has not worked out that well and that has to be a concern. Bye Bye Hong Kong was an impressive winner of a novice race at Windsor last time out and he remains open to further improvement.
