ATR VERDICT: All-the-way Britannia Stakes winner OSTILIO narrowly missed out on the hat-trick when second in a Group 3 at Goodwood, and if repeating his impressive form from this season back in the handicap ranks, he shouldn't be too far away at the finish. Similar sentiments also apply to Whisky Baron, who went close at Pattern level on his first start for William Haggas on the Sussex Downs and was a prolific winner when racing in South Africa. Fire Brigade is a consistent performer who should be capable of making the podium but could struggle to pass the aforementioned duo.
