ATR VERDICT: Despite this contest being an Aidan O'Brien benefit, having won five of the six renewals, there was an awful lot to like about the debut performance of MADHMOON. The son of Dawn Approach quickened up in the manner of a very smart individual to beat subsequent winner Sydney Opera House over course and distance. He took an age to pull up afterwards, which suggests there was plenty left in the tank, and he can confirm that form with Sydney Opera House, who also looks capable of further progression. Broome will benefit from the step back up in trip having struggled in the Acomb, while Masaff defied greenness to win over C&D in June on debut and completes the shortlist.
