ATR VERDICT: ALPHA CENTAURI has arguably been the star of the season so far, readily winning four Group 1 races in as many months. The form of her latest success at Deauville took a massive boost when the runner-up reappeared to win the Prix du Moulin last weekend, and Jessica Harrington's filly can stamp her authority on this contest. Laurens didn't appear to see out the 1m4f trip in the Yorkshire Oaks and returning to a mile should suit the English 1000 Guineas runner-up. Dual Group 2 winner Magical is the pick of the Ballydoyle team and can run her usual honest race.
