ATR VERDICT: Willie Mullins holds the aces and his trio is spearheaded by CAP D'AUBOIS, who made a successful return to action at Killarney when producing a good round of jumping and scoring with plenty left in the tank. He can account for stable companion Minella Beau, who disposed of subsequent winner Caltex at Galway, and the third Closutton inmate Robin Des Foret, who was a good third in a Grade 3 at the Ballybrit fixture. Gusty Rocky's jumping is a worry at this level.
