ATR VERDICT: Anthony Van Dyck was only half a length in front of Christmas when winning the Futurity over C&D three weeks ago, although he appeared to have more in hand than the margin suggested. That said, the son of Galileo may have to take another step forward to beat QUORTO, who created a big impression when winning the Superlative Stakes by nearly four lengths. Charlie Appleby's colt should be capable of making his mark at this level based on that evidence.
