**ATR VERDICT:** LEONCAVALLO has been revitalised by the switch to Dr Richard Newland's stable, starting off with a decisive Ludlow triumph before a cracking effort to make the frame in the Galway Hurdle. He isn't bred for fences but providing he can put in a clear round, his quality should see him home. Cultivator has had a crack at the bigger obstacles before, with limited success, and it isn't ideal that he arrives following a hurdles tumble at Newton Abbot, but he has a touch of class. Flashing Glance was a solid third on his chasing bow and will be waiting to pick up the pieces should the top two falter.
