ATR VERDICT: Theo has won six of his nine starts since coming under the care of Dr Richard Newland, most recently following a seven-month absence over course and distance, and a 5lb rise doesn't appear too harsh. Dinsdale lost little in defeat at Sedgefield, and Roman Flight has slipped to a handy mark, but PETER THE MAYO MAN gets the nod. The eight-year-old wasn't entirely reliable for Paul Nicholls but he has been snapped up for 26,000 pounds since he was last seen and Dan Skelton doesn't usually take long to find the key to new recruits.
