The winner went on to account for Little India a little more comfortably at Lingfield, although Karl Burke's filly still has to be considered closely following that pleasing introduction. Accredited wasn't far behind the selection here, while Mulhima's Wolverhampton third was promising, and the debutants Ideological and Eesha Lovely also enter the equation.
