ATR VERDICT: LEDHAM broke through on his all-weather debut at Wolverhampton in May and then returned from a short holiday to fill the runner-up spot on his handicap bow at Sandown. He is up 1lb but is open to any amount of improvement on just his fifth appearance, and the switch to the Polytrack may also help. Wufud landed the odds to break his duck at Ffos Las but an initial rating of 83 appears on the high side. Mudallel and Kingston Kurrajong struggled in the London Mile Final here but will find this more to their liking, and Hombre Casado and Mushtaq can play a part too.
