Clive Cox's charge is out of an Arch mare, so should handle an artificial surface. Enbihaar showed his aptitude for the all-weather when third on her debut for John Gosden and looks a major danger, though Butterfield went well on his first outing at Goodwood and would have every chance if building on that.
