ATR VERDICT: BEAT LE BON showed very good promise on his debut here when only finding Momkin too strong, with the pair pulling clear of the remainder. The form hasn't exactly worked out since, but the extra furlong is guaranteed to suit and he has had some decent entries in recent weeks. Palavecino links closely with the selection having beaten Momkin, who was conceding him 7lb, at Ffos Las last month and is capable of improvement. Any market support for newcomer Raakib Alhawa should be noted, with his sire Kingman having an excellent start to his stallion career.
