ATR VERDICT: Exec Chef thrived on his return to turf when winning here over a mile and if proving just as effective stepping up in trip, has a fantastic chance of landing a hat-trick. Rock Force has made the podium on all four starts so far and proved he handles the distance when second at York, while Armed, the useful dual-purpose performer New Agenda, and the hooded Western Duke all make each-way appeal. However, this could come down to a tussle between recent winners Gododdin and ZZORO, who were both partnered to success by talented apprentice Jason Watson last time. Watson stays loyal to Hugo Palmer's three-year-old, who carries a 6lb penalty for his Brighton success, but preference is for Amanda Perrett's Epsom winner, who has the assistance of Ryan Moore now.
