**ATR VERDICT:** Salazar has had a wind operation but was 26 lengths behind Twilight when last seen. The latter was disappointing at Newcastle last time, but first-time cheekpieces and a return to turf should see Tim Easterby's charge in a better light. Footstepsintime has been poor the last twice but is capable on his day, although the claims of WENSLEY are more appealing. The three-year-old likes soft ground and has dropped to a very tempting mark of 63 now wearing first-time cheekpieces.
