ATR VERDICT: CLOUDLAM represents a trainer who is 4-10 here in the last five years and can build on a previously promising debut at Chelmsford. The three-year-old is a half-sister to a winner over 7f, and should appreciate this drop in trip to 1m. That was a hot race on paper with the right yards dominating at the finish and she might have too much for Jamil, who has weight to concede, and Never Be Enough, who finished behind the latter last time at Carlisle.
