ATR VERDICT: Rollicking has been in cracking form on the turf and warrants plenty of respect on her all-weather debut, but it might pay to side with the proven course form of STORM SHELTER. He built on last month's second when scoring readily 19 days ago, both over C&D, and although a 14lb rise will obviously make life a lot tougher, there should be plenty more to come from him. The hat-trick seeking Hard Taskmaster and handicap debutant Shellbrook are others to note.

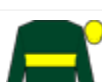

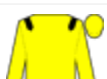
