ATR VERDICT: The 250,000gns Dark Angel gelding WELSH LORD was eased down when notching up a three-length victory on his seasonal reappearance earlier this month and the lightly-raced Godolphin charge should be more than capable of another bold showing having thrived for the step up to this trip at Chelmsford. Pontefract winner Hareeq was somewhat disappointing on soft ground at Carlisle but is still of interest going up in trip and running on the all-weather for the first time, while Dono Di Dio and My Heart have both hit the frame of late and are others to note.
