ATR VERDICT: PEPPAY LE PUGH is yet another to thrive since joining Dan Skelton's string this summer, unbeaten in two starts for the Alcester handler, and despite a 15lb hike from the assessor for his Sedgefield triumph earlier this month, he rates as the one to beat once again in search of a hat-trick. All Is Good is interesting following a summer break and his most recent efforts offer optimism, while Cap Du Nord has been a bit hit and miss since scoring at Sandown in December, but it is interesting that Richard Johnson is booked in the saddle for the five-year-old's first chase start.
