**ATR VERDICT:** Irish raiders Duquesa Beach and Scealai Aonair are both of serious interest here, with the latter back down to the distance she scored over at Clonmel in the summer, while Curragh handler John James Fearn also brings across his Ffos Las scorer Syndicate, who shouldn't be far away once again. Alabanza has won two of his last three starts, including over track and trip, and has to be on the shortlist, but preference is for SARVI, who got off the mark over course and distance last time and could give Jim Goldie another local victory.
