ATR VERDICT: Rolling Maul has found a resurgence in form having won his last two outings at Worcester and Perth, but now has to contend with a hefty rise in the handicap. Timeforben won over C&D last month where she appeared to relish the step up in trip along with the addition of first-time blinkers, and a 7lb rise seems fair for that effort. Clondaw Cian lost his way over fences last season, but has gone well fresh over timber in the past and is 2lb higher than his last winning mark. The vote, however, goes to VODKA ALL THE WAY, who ended last season with a win at Exeter in a novice hurdle and he looks to have the potential for further improvement in handicaps.
