ATR VERDICT: Last year's winner Limato has returned to form, after struggling in the first half of the season, winning in Listed company the last twice here on the July course and at York last month. He is top rated in the field and, if running to his best, would undoubtedly be tough to beat. That said, the level of form in those victories this year doesn't amount to much, and D'BAI arguably brings the strongest recent piece of form to the table. His second in the Park Stakes to Mustashry at Doncaster was backed up by that rival going on to win the Joel Stakes here, and Charlie Appleby's gelding can continue the excellent form of the stable. Mankib and Dancing Star both come into this at the top of their game and cannot be discounted up in class.
