ATR VERDICT: TWILIGHT PAYMENT picked up the silver medal in a 2m Group 3 at Naas when last sighted and is expected to step up on that effort now cutting back in trip and eased into Listed company. Jaega is lightly raced beyond 1m2f and is worth a market check now sporting first-time blinkers, though a bigger danger may be Sir Erec, an unexposed Ballydoyle inmate who steps up in grade after landing a 1m2f Curragh maiden in August. The King is another capable of going well on these terms.
