ATR VERDICT: CHAMERON has only had one start for Paul Nicholls, finishing second of four in a novice chase at Exeter last November. However, he was a dual hurdles winner in France and he's undergone a wind operation in his time off the track, so he may well be capable of making up for lost time. Debece developed into a useful hurdler last year, finishing third in Grade 1 company at Aintree, and is interesting now debuting over fences. Minella Awards is another who could go well if transferring his best hurdles form over the larger obstacles.
