ATR VERDICT: Drakefell has evidently had his problems but the fact he won on his first start for four months in March suggests he could be a factor on his first outing since. Equimou took advantage of a falling mark to score at Salisbury last time but has been handed a 9lb rise for those exertions, so preference is for ISLAND OF LIFE. William Haggas' filly has been a model of consistency since winning at Sandown in June and tries a variety of headgear on her first start since a wind operation here, all of which could improve her.
